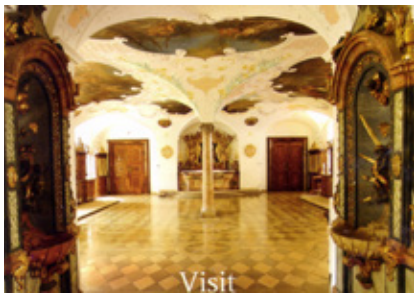


KLOSTERBRAUEREI ETTAL

IKlosterbrauerei Ettal is one of the very last remaining authentic German monastic breweries still operated and managed by its “true” owners, the monks of the Holy Rule of St. Benedict.

Since 1330 the monastery Kloster Ettal has lived and worked in accordance with the Holy Rule of St. Benedict. Since 1609, the monastery’s own businesses - its brewery & distillery, and farming - have provided the funds to sustain its centuries-old buildings, art treasures and educational facilities.

Evidence since the 16th century, the Benedictine monks of Ettal Abbey brew their much-praised specialities. Using fine malt and hops from Bavarian growing regions, special beers are brewed with the crystal clear and pure water of the Ammergebirge according to the Bavarian Purity Law.

Appearance	This stunning marzen lager hits the glass with the truest of amber color, and a delicate white head sits atop the beer, inviting you in.
Aroma	The aroma immediately entices you with caramel, chestnut and fresh baked whole grain bread.
Flavor	All the aromatics shine through on the palate, but there is more at play here. There is a lovely fruit note, a little plum, a hint of apple, and it is complimented with the perfect amount of earthy hop bitterness underneath it all.
Finish	The finish is long without being overwhelming, leaving this liquid nearly impossible to get out of your mind. So drinkable, so memorable, so wonderful.
