Created at Harveys traditional country brewery in Lewes, East-Sussex, its perennial Elizabethan Ale was first brewed in 1953 to celebrate the coronation of Queen Elizabeth II.

Maris Otter, Pipkin Ale, and crystal malts are selected to give the Elizabethan Ale its intense color and fullness of palate. For balance, Fuggle, Golding and Progress hops are used in the brewkettle.
